<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Zambia's name comes from the Zambezi River. Zambezi is from a local word yambezhi "heart of all". 2. Iron and copper have been mined in Zambia for over 2000 years. Today Zambia is the world's 5th largest producer of copper. 3. Victoria Falls in Zambia is one of the seven natural wonders of the world. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Zimbabwe has an adult literacy rate of approximately 90% which is amongst the highest in Africa, behind only Seychelles and ahead of Botswana, South Africa, Nigeria and Kenya. 2. Zimbabwe is home to one of the most spectacular waterfalls the Victoria Falls in the world. With a width of 1.7 kilometres, they form the largest sheet of falling water in the world. 3. The King of Reggae music, Bob Marley, was greatly inspired by the liberation struggle Zimbabwe. So much so that he wrote a song called Zimbabwe in honour of the country's freedom and consequent name change from Rhodesia to Zimbabwe. In April 1980 he was invited to perform at the country's independence celebrations.
