






What's the difference?

Gender

"Either of the two main categories (male and female) into which humans and most other living things are divided on the basis of their reproductive functions." (Oxford Living Dictionaries, 2017)




GENDER AND SEX ARE FUNDAMENTALLY DIFFERENT


