WorldWise Global Schools is an Irish Aid programme for development education in Irish post-primary schools. Our aim is to increase students' knowledge and understanding of global justice issues. WWGS support helps to build the capacity of schools (and especially teachers) to engage with development education and to empower students to fulfil their role as active global citizens.

Development Education is for you! It is...

- A direct response to global poverty and injustice
- An active, skills-based approach to education
- A way to work in solidarity with people from different parts of the world
- An empowering experience for both students and teachers
- Working to analyse, understand and eradicate the roots causes of inequality
- Already part of the post-primary curriculum and of teaching/learning in many Irish schools

What can we apply for under the Grant Call 2015?

Successful applicants will be supported to integrate development education into curricular and extracurricular activities as well as the overall school life, ethos and policy. Examples of activities that may be funded include:

- Teacher capacity building
- Student activities and engagement (such as debates, seminars, exhibitions and action research projects)
- Joint learning projects between schools in Ireland and partner schools in the global South
- Whole-school activities and events to share learning

Development education activities may focus on a range of themes, for example;

Climate Change

- Gender Justice
- Human Rights
- Social Justice/Inequality •
- Trade/Fairtrade
- Sustainable Development Goals Women & Development
- Conflict

- Poverty & Disease
- Overconsumption
- Structural causes of poverty
